### The Surgical Transitions Remote Patient Monitoring program SeamlessMD is available for surgical patients in Northwestern Ontario

- Using the digital platform SeamlessMD, nurse practitioners are providing Remote Patient Monitoring to surgical patients across Northwestern Ontario
- Through the platform, patients have access to a clinician-reviewed library of both pre- and post-operative resources
- Patients can engage in daily checklists to promote self management, and health surveys that assist in identifying any issues or concerns for 30 days following surgery
- If an issue is identified, a nurse practitioner will connect with the patient via phone

- SeamlessMD is available for patients in Northwestern Ontario involved in Bariatric, Breast, Colorectal, Gynecology, Orthopaedic (Hip, Knee, and Shoulder), Spine, and Urology surgeries from all four surgery sites (Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre, Lake of the Woods District Hospital, Dryden Regional Health Centre, and Riverside Health Care).

### How we can help you and your patients:

- Instead of calls to your office, accessing the Emergency Department or walk-in clinics, patients can connect with a member of our team to address post-operative issues
- If your patient has a post-operative related concern and needs assistance during business hours (Monday to Friday, 8:00 am. – 4:00 p.m. EST), and have undergone a qualifying surgery (see list attached), they can be directed to our service for support
