Surgical Transitions Remote Patient Monitoring is available for post-operative patients in Northwestern Ontario

- Using the digital platform SeamlessMD, nurse practitioners are providing Remote Patient Monitoring to surgical patients across Northwestern Ontario
- Through the platform, patients have access to a clinician-reviewed library of both pre- and post-operative resources
- Patients can engage in daily checklists to promote self management, and health surveys that assist in identifying any issues or concerns for 30 days following surgery
- If an issue is identified, a nurse practitioner will connect with the patient via phone

How we can help you and your patients:

- Instead of calls to your office, accessing the Emergency Department or walk-in clinics, patients can connect with a member of our team to address post-operative issues
- If your patient has a post-operative related concern and needs assistance during business hours (Monday to Friday, 8:00 am. – 4:00 p.m. EST), and have undergone a qualifying surgery (see list attached), they can be directed to our service for support

- Encourage your patients to engage in the program both pre- and post-operatively
- Keep Novari ATC up to date and accurate - it is our access for rostering patients. Ensure all patients are notified of their surgery at the time of entering them into Novari ATC
